
Each LC Star File takes the form of a brief interview, with the featured LC-ite answering a set of questions designed to give readers a glimpse of the personality behind the name.


We have featured five LC-ite entrepreneurs and their businesses so far via 'She Means Business' and the series will continue into the new year,

LC Cares continues to support senior Old Girls with the Wellness Phone Call program as well as providing helpful information on the delivery of groceries, other essentials and meals. LC Cares also offers guidance and counselling to those who need it, and checks in with participants of LC Cares on a bi-monthly basis either by phone call, text or email.

LC Care remains committed to serving its members during this unprecedented global health crisis, recognising that for many of the more senior members of the LC OGA family, the COVID-19 outbreak in Sri Lanka has brought stress, anxiety and loneliness. LC Cares is currently exploring ways to help our senior members stay positive, active and engaged while staying at home.
