LC Walk 2010

The LC Walk 2010 was held on Saturday 31st July 2010 and was organized by the OGA, the PTA and the School as a Fund Raising event to commence construction of the Sports Complex. The theme chosen for the Walk was “100 years down Flower Road.” The History of the School was depicted on the floats representing each era. The first float depicted the Ms Nixon and Ms Whitney era, the second one the Ms Gwen Opie era, the third one the Ms Simon and Ms Hitchcock era, and the fourth float depicted the Sri Lankan Principals, namely Mrs. Sirancee Gunawardene, Ms Sriyani Mittapala and Mrs. Nirmali Wickremasinghe.

Just prior to the commencement of the Walk, the Principal Mrs. Nirmali Wickremasinghe planted two Flamboyant Trees, one within the School premises and the other just outside the School gate, to commemorate the occasion.

The Parade started with a Prayer followed by the School Hymn and left the School premises with a roll of drums. The parade was led by the School Hewisi Band followed by the Head Girl carrying the School flag. She was flanked by the Games Captain, Prefects in Blazers, and House Captains with House flags, Sports Captains and Sportswomen who have represented Sri Lanka overseas. The Principal, Vice Principal, Chairman of the Board of Management, Manager of the School and the President OGA also lead the Walk.

The Principal released 100 red and white balloons at the Main gate at the commencement of the Walk. Most of the participants were smartly clad in the LC Walk T shirt and Cap worn with white pants or blue jeans. The Nursery children were outside the School entrance to waive their flags as the parade started off.

At the conclusion of the Walk there was a mini fair with food, drink and other miscellaneous stalls. The back garden was well decorated and had a festive air. There was music provided by a DJ and the girls enjoyed themselves after the Walk on the Rides and other entertainment available.

We are happy to report that we have exceeded the target of Rs 10 million required to lay the “floating foundation” for the new Sports Complex, which will house the Indoor Badminton and Squash Courts and a well equipped Gymnasium for the School.

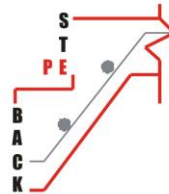
