FIRST VIRTUAL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The 111th Annual General Meeting (“AGM”) of the Ladies’ College Old Girls’ Association (“LC OGA”) was held on 13th March 2021. This year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and consequent restrictions on gatherings, the Executive Committee decided to hold the AGM via audio-visual means for the first time in the history of the LC OGA.

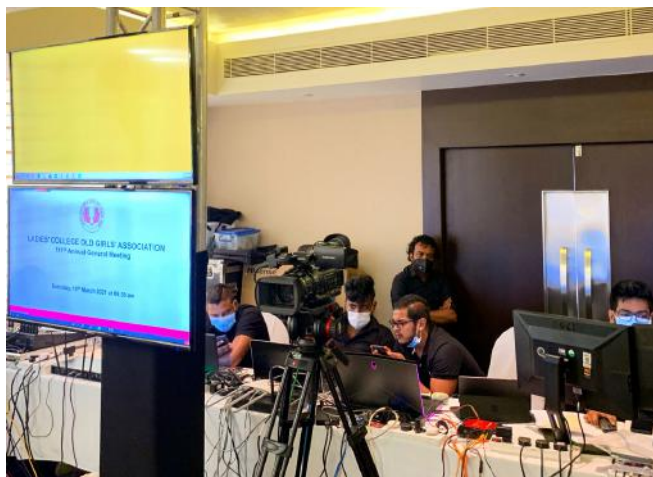
The AGM commenced with the customary prayer by the Patroness, Mrs Eesha Speldewinde, followed by a welcome speech by the President, Mrs Fathima Aziz, who explained the reasons for conducting a virtual AGM, and highlighted the events organised by the LC OGA for the period from October 2019 to February 2021. These included the online initiatives that the LC OGA organized to maintain a sense of community and fellowship amongst the membership despite the COVID-19 pandemic. Following the President’s address, the Hony. Secretary, Mrs Nirusha Ranjitkumar Ratnatunga ran through the administrative matters on the agenda.

Mrs. Aruni De Mel, Ms. Nirupa Karunaratne and Mrs. Sepalika Happugoda were reappointed as trustees of the OGA Trust, having completed their first three-year term. Ms. Kishani Asirwatham was appointed to replace Ms. Malathi Algama (who completed her term) as a trustee of the OGA Chapel Trust. The Hony. auditor, Ms. Chandrika Wijeratne was reappointed, having indicated her willingness to serve another term. Mrs. Speldewinde gave a brief overview of School news for the year, focusing primarily on the new modes of technology introduced by the School to deliver quality education, the distance learning methods introduced by the School during the lock-down period and consequent closure of schools, as well as the precautionary measures taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19 following the re-opening of the School.



All members who registered to participate in the AGM were sent a link to an online voting platform via email. Participants then cast their vote online for each resolution taken up for voting.

Amendments to the Constitution

The following resolutions to amend the Constitution of the Ladies' College Old Girls' Association ("Constitution") were passed unanimously by those voting:

- Amendment to Rule 20 of the Constitution to change the financial year of the LC OGA to commence on 1 April and end on 31 March each year.
- Amendment to Rule 16(1)(f)(b) of the Constitution to amend the period for the preparation of interim accounts.
- Amendments to Rule 9(1)(a) and Rule 9(1)(b) and Rule 17 of the Constitution to create a new post of Assistant Publicity Secretary on the Executive Committee.
- Amendment to Rule 12(2) of the Constitution to change the procedure for holding Annual General Meetings, so as to allow for the conduct of virtual Annual General Meetings, should circumstances require.
- Amendment to Rule 12(3) of the Constitution to reduce the quorum requirement for an Annual General Meeting from 100 to 60.
- Amendments to the OGA Trust Fund Deed to cover the objects of LC Cares, to accommodate a representative of LC Cares on the Board of Trustees of the OGA Trust and to introduce other amendments to enable the smooth and transparent administration of the OGA Trust.
- Amendments to the OGA Chapel Trust Fund Deed, similar to those made to the OGA Trust Fund Deed, to enable the smooth functioning of the OGA Chapel Trust.

ONLINE INITIATIVES

Following the outbreak of COVID-19 in Sri Lanka a year ago and the subsequent restrictions imposed by the Government on gatherings, we have been unable to hold any physical events for the past year. Undeterred by this, the Executive Committee of the LC OGA continued with its online initiatives in late 2020 and early 2021, organizing a number of activities to keep our members engaged and entertained.

The Ruby Room - LC OGA Virtual Book Club

The second session of The Ruby Room was held in late November 2020. We had a smaller turnout for this session on Bernadine Evaristo's 2019 Booker Prize winner, *Girl, Woman, Other* which was ably moderated by Shalini Wickramasuriya, however, the discussion was no less lively or enthusiastic - if at all, the more intimate group allowed for a really in-depth discussion on a range of topics related to the book. We hope to organize further sessions of The Ruby Room for our avid LCite readers in the coming year.

Virtual Demonstrations

Prompted by the surge of interest in home-cooking during the lockdown period, the LC OGA organized two further cook-alongs in December 2020 and January 2021.

The program consisted of a selection of hymns sung by the LC OGA Choir, a welcome by Mrs Fathima Aziz (President, LC OGA), a reading of 'Footprints in the Sand' by Ms Anisha Wijewardane (Publicity Secretary, LC OGA) and a prayer of thanksgiving by Mrs Eesha Speldewinde (Principal, Ladies' College).
