














The wait is over, Ladies! Christmas is upon us! But as the season kicks into gear, there is one question truly worth pondering:



A quick, easy, and festive treat to bring Christmas cheer to your goodies table! 💝

# Ingredients

Pastry
(12 cases + 12 stars)

150g flour
75g Astra margarine
20g icing sugar
1/4 tsp mixed spice

# Filling

600g Christmas cake (80% baked – when baking your Christmas cake, remove a portion just before it's fully done)

Brandy Butter 50g butter
50g icing sugar
5 tbsp brandy

# Method

Combine flour, icing sugar, mixed spice, and Astra. Rub with fingertips until it forms a crumbly texture.

Add a little water at a time—just enough to bring the dough together.

Lightly dust your board, roll out the pastry (not too thin), cut with a 3" cutter, and line a cupcake tray. Cut stars with the remaining pastry.

Blind bake the pastry cases with cupcake liners and rice to keep the shape. Place the stars on the tray too.

Bake for 15 minutes.

Remove the liners, rice, and stars. Fill the pastry cups evenly with the Christmas cake and bake for another 10 minutes.

Cool, top each pie with a pastry star, and dust lightly with icing sugar.

For extra festive cheer, serve warm with a dollop of brandy butter!







# Ingredients

## • Epsom salt – 200g

- Plain Rock Salt 50g
- Lavender Buds 2g
- Green Food Colouring 1 tiny drop (a little goes a long way)
- Eucalyptus Essential Oil 2g 5 drops
- Peppermint/Spearmint Essential Oil 2g - 5 drops
- Pine Needle Essential Oil 1g 3 drops

For storge -Glass jars or bottles (must be airtight)



# Method

### Step 1

Weigh out your salts, and mix well. Add all your essential oils and mix again.

### Step 2

Split the salt into 2 parts, add Lavender buds to one lot and a tiny drop of green food colouring to the other

half.

### Step 3

Take the jar or container you are using to store the salts and layer one plain (with buds) layer and then on top a green layer and alternate the layers until jar is almost full.

### Step 4

Add a wooden spoon (optional), one can use a wooden or stainless steel spoon to scoop out the salts. Try not to use wet fingers, as salts get moist and spoil.


### Step 5

Add a Christmas sticker or ribbon and a tag if gifting the item.

The whole process will take less than 10 minutes and is safe enough for kids to join in with adult supervision. It's a fun project and these salts can just as easily be used as a foot soak for those that have no time for long baths.

You can purchase any ingredients that you do not have at home from www.cavemanredux.com, (I am in no way connected to this store, however I do get ingredients there myself for R & D projects and they have a good selection and the quality is good for the price.)













# Materials needed

1.Vases/tealight holder

2 .Candles- taper/pillar/votive

3 .Wet (green)or dry foam

4 .Scissors

5 .Toothpicks

6 .Rubber bands

7. Decorative christmas decor - faux or fresh

(Pine, eucalyptus, fern, baubles, berries, pinecone, silver/gold trimmings)





# Step 2

Place the foam as seen. I've used the wet foam-dry (without wetting it)

# Step 3 The decorating begins 🌲

1.Better to begin with the foliage, that too easier if you start with the four sides & slowly build it in.

2.Start adding the berries, baubles etc. Keep turning the arrangement ever so often whilst adding the sundries to make sure its a balanced arrangement.
